About Individual Community Living Support (ICLS)

It's designed for older adults who want to remain independent.



What is ICLS?

ICLS covers assistance and support for **eligible people who are age 65 and older** and enrolled in the Alternative Care (AC) program or the Elderly Waiver (EW).

Who is ICLS for?

The ICLS program is designed for adults age 65 and older who want to remain in their own homes but who may need:

- Reminders and cues
- Intermittent/moderate supervision
- Physical assistance

What support is provided?

It's a bundled service to support people with:

- Cognitive challenges
- Adopting ways to meet their needs
- Activities of daily living (ADLs)
- Management of their home
- Maintenance of their overall wellbeing
- Meaningful integration and participation in their community

What's the difference between ICLS services and PCA services?

While ICLS is designed for people age 65 and over, PCA services help **eligible people of any age** who are enrolled in a Minnesota Health Care Program and need help with daily activities in the home and community, including:

- Health-related procedures and tasks
- Observation and redirection of behaviors
- Help with instrumental activities of daily living for adults



What Personal Care Assistance (PCA) services do you need?

Decide what kind of PCA services are right for you or your loved one.



There are two types of PCA service models and Integra offers both.

1 Traditional PCA Service Model

Traditional PCA allows Integra Health Care, Inc., to play a more active role. Integra Health Care, Inc., is in charge of making employment decisions, but our clients can still give their Personal Care Assistants daily direction and may adjust the PCA's schedule to meet their needs.

As the employer, **Integra** is responsible for:

- Hiring, training, scheduling, and dismissing PCA staff members
- Providing backup PCA staff when necessary
- Developing Care Plans In consultation with our clients and/or their Responsible Parties
- Overseeing and evaluating PCA staff members
- Meeting all employment laws and requirements
- Monitoring PCA hours

2 PCA Choice Service Model

This PCA service option gives our clients more control. You or your Responsible Party is considered the employer, and Integra acts as your fiscal intermediary.

As the client and/or Responsible Party, **you** are accountable for:

- Developing Care Plans you can elect to have assistance from a Qualified Professional.
- Finding, hiring, training, scheduling, monitoring, and firing PCAs
- Finding backup PCAs.
- Have more input on PCA wages
- Monitor PCA hours
- Maintain documentation of PCA tasks and actions

Why clients choose one PCA service over the other

Traditional PCA Service Model

When clients want our agency to find staff, they select *Traditional PCA* services.

The traditional option gives us the freedom to be more flexible with our clients.

For example, many of our clients elect to schedule their own PCAs but have us take care of all the steps involved with hiring and firing PCAs.

PCA Choice Service Model

When clients have their own Personal Care Worker or Workers, usually family or friends who can cover all his shifts, they generally choose *PCA Choice*.



Frequently Asked Questions

Does Integra work with my health plan?

Currently, Integra Health Care works with Medical Assistance, Medica, Health Partners and Blue Plus/Blue Cross Blue Shield health plans. However, as these partnerships change from time to time, it is best to call our office for confirmation. We also provide services to persons with Waivered services through their county.

How can I find out whether I'm eligible for home health services?

You must be eligible for Medical Assistance. Please contact us or your local health agency to determine your eligibility.

Eligibility requirements: You must be assessed by a Public Health Nurse in the County you live in to see if you need PCA services. If you are the patient, you must be able to make decisions regarding your care or have a Responsible Party who can make decisions for you. For example, a minor child under the age of 18 or a person not able to make his or her own decisions due to a physical or mental disability requires a designated Responsible Party.

Who can be my responsible party?

A Responsible Party is the formal designation for the person who will be making the health care decisions for the person requiring home health services. The requirements for a Responsible Party include:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Cannot be your PCA
- Must be available to the patient and the PCA and help to monitor care

- Must attend the Public Health Nurse Assessment
- Must be prepared to sign any documents related to home health services

If I qualify to receive services, what is the next step?

Once you're verified to receive services, we'll begin the process of assigning a PCA who can best accommodate the needs of your loved one. All of our PCAs must have the required training, complete our application materials, and pass our background check.

Integra will assign a Nurse Case Manager, who will visit you and, if required, train your PCA or PCAs to make sure your care needs are met. The Nurse Case Manager will also answer any questions you may have and make certain you're happy with your services.


